Nesbit, William H.—Jr. 2d Lieutenant May 13, 1862. Wounded at Crow's Valley, Ga. May 1863; Missionary Ridge, Tenn. Nov. 25, 1863. Captured at Nashville, Tenn. Dec. 16, 1864. Released at Johnson's Island, O. June 17, 1865.

Atkinson, Joseph P.—1st Sergeant May 13, 1862. Wounded at Vicksburg, Miss. July 4, 1863. Surrendered at Greensboro, N. C. Apr. 26, 1865. (Born Nov. 30, 1834.)

Walker, J. J.—2d Sergeant May 13, 1862. Captured at Nashville, Tenn. Dec. 16, 1864. Released at Camp Chase, O. June 12, 1865. (Resident of Georgia since 1846.)

Mills, Milledge—3d Sergeant May 13, 1862. No later record.

Akins, John B.—4th Sergeant May 13, 1862. Appointed 3d Sergeant. Died at home in Heard County, Ga. in 1863.

Mosely, Edward N.—5th Sergeant May 13, 1862. Captured at Vicksburg, Miss. July 4, 1863, and paroled there July 8, 1863. Pension records show he was wounded at New Hope Church, Ga. June 1864. No later record. (Born Mch. 20, 1832.)

Akins, James M.—1st Corporal May 13, 1862. Captured at Vicksburg, Miss. July 4, 1863, and paroled there July 8, 1863. No later record.

Bryan, John M. (or John N.)—2d Corporal May 13, 1862. Surrendered at Greensboro, N. C. Apr. 26, 1865.

Bracey, Ed L. (or Ed N.)—3d Corporal May 13, 1862. Died in hospital Nov. 7, 1862.

Levens, William F.—4th Corporal May 13, 1862. Captured at Vicksburg, Miss. July 4, 1863, and paroled there July 8, 1863. No later record.

Adams, James A.—Private May 13, 1862. Captured at Vicksburg, Miss. July 4, 1863, and paroled there July 8, 1863. Wounded at Atlanta, Ga. July 22, 1864. Surrendered at Greensboro, N. C. Apr. 26, 1865.

Adams, Jesse A.—Private May 13, 1862. Captured at Vicksburg, Miss. July 4, 1863, and paroled there July 8, 1863. Captured at Nashville, Tenn. Dec. 16, 1864. Released at Camp Chase, O. June 12, 1865.

Adams, N. D. (or W. D.)—Private May 13, 1862. Pension records show he surrendered at Greensboro, N. C. Apr. 26, 1865.

Akins, Lee L.—Private May 13, 1862. At C. S. Arsenal Feb. 28, 1864. Paroled at Montgomery, Ala. May 23, 1865.

Austin, James C.—Private May 13, 1862. Captured near Franklin, Tenn. Dec. 17, 1864. Released at Camp Chase, O. June 12, 1865. (Born in Florence, Ala. in 1821.)

Barker, William Z.—Private May 13, 1862. No later record.

Barnes, Jesse M.—Private June 27, 1862. Surrendered at Greensboro, N. C. Apr. 26, 1865. (Born in Georgia in 1838. Died in Carroll County, Ga. Mch. 1922.)

Beal, Wesley J.—Private Nov. 13, 1862. Captured at Vicksburg, Miss. July 4, 1863, and paroled there July 8, 1863. Surrendered at Greensboro, N. C. Apr. 26, 1865.

Bell, Frank—Private May 13, 1862. Died at Chattanooga, Tenn. Aug. 1, 1862.

Bell, James J.—Private May 13, 1862. Pension records show he surrendered at Greensboro, N. C. Apr. 26, 1865. (Born in Carroll County, Ga. Dec. 29, 1840.)

Bell, John—Private May 13, 1862. Pension records show he surrendered at Greensboro, N. C. Apr. 26, 1865. (Born in Georgia Feb. 15, 1841.)

Combs, Mark—Private May 13, 1862. Captured at Vicksburg, Miss. July 4, 1863, and paroled there July 8, 1863. No later record.

Cosby, W. W.—Private Dec. 25, 1863. Surrendered at Greensboro, N. C. Apr. 26, 1865.

Craven, Andrew J.—Private May 13, 1862. Captured at Vicksburg, Miss. July 4, 1863, and paroled there July 8, 1863. Wounded at Atlanta, Ga. July 22, 1864. Died of wounds in 1864.

Craven, James K. P.—Private May 13, 1862. Appointed 3d Corporal Nov. 7, 1862. Captured at Vicksburg, Miss. July 4, 1863, and paroled there July 8, 1863. No later record.

Craven, John S.—Private May 13, 1862. Captured at Vicksburg, Miss. July 4, 1863, and paroled there July 8, 1863. No later record.

Craven, Wilson L.—Private May 13, 1862. Appointed Sergeant. Captured at Vicksburg, Miss. July 4, 1863, and paroled there July 8, 1863. Pension records show he was wounded at Nashville, Tenn. Dec. 16, 1864, and was at home on wounded furlough close of war.

Crews, G. B.—Private May 13, 1862. No later record.

Crews, Willis G.—Private May 13, 1862. Surrendered at Greensboro, N. C. Apr. 26, 1865.

Crews, W. J.—Private May 13, 1862. No later record.

Curry, William—Private May 13, 1862. No later record.

Daniel, John A.—Private May 13, 1862. Captured at Vicksburg, Miss. July 4, 1863, and paroled there July 8, 1863. Pension records show he was wounded in left groin in Mississippi May 23, 1863. Surrendered at Greensboro, N. C. Apr. 26, 1865. (Born at Barnesville, Ga. Nov. 8, 1841.)

Daniel, John T.—Private Sept. 1863. Pension records show he was discharged at Augusta, Ga., date not given. (Born in Baldwin County, Ga.)

Daniel, William F.—Private Mar. 2, 1863. Died of disease Apr. 22, 1863.

Davis, William J., Sr.—Private May 13, 1862. Captured at Vicksburg, Miss. July 4, 1863, and paroled there July 8, 1863. Pension records show he surrendered at Greensboro, N. C. Apr. 26, 1865. (Born in Heard County, Ga. Mch. 18, 1839.)

Dukes, G. A.—Private May 13, 1862. Killed accidentally in 1864.

Dukes, W. W.—Private Sept. 1863. Pension records show he surrendered at Greensboro, N. C. Apr. 26, 1865. (Born in South Carolina in 1818.)

Farrow, William T.—Private May 13, 1862. Died at Vicksburg, Miss. July 4, 1863.

Garrett, John—Private May 13, 1862. Died of chronic diarrhoea in Blackie Hospital at Madison, Ga. Mch. 26, 1864.

Garrett, W. J.—Private May 13, 1862. Wounded at Crow's Valley, Ga. May 1863. Captured at Vicksburg, Miss. July 4, 1863, and paroled there July 8, 1863. In Stout Hospital at Madison, Ga. Mch. 1, 1864. No later record.

Gay, W. J.—Private May 13, 1862. Captured at Vicksburg, Miss. July 4, 1863, and paroled there July 8, 1863. Appointed Corporal. Surrendered at Greensboro, N. C. Apr. 26, 1865.

Gordon, M. F.—Private May 13, 1862. Died at Vicksburg, Miss. in 1864.

Hammonds, Robert (or Hammond)—Private May 13, 1862. Died in hospital July 27, 1862.

Harris, Beverly S.—Private May 13, 1862. Killed at Vicksburg, Miss. July 4, 1863.

Harris, G. B.—Private May 13, 1862. Died in camp at Lookout Mountain, Tenn. Dec. 9, 1862.

Harris, Lazarus H.—Private May 13, 1862. Appointed Corporal in 1862. Captured at Vicksburg, Miss. July 4, 1863, and paroled there July 8, 1863. No later record.

Harris, Sanders Favors—Private May 13, 1862. Captured at Missionary Ridge, Tenn. Nov. 25, 1863. Sent to Rock Island, Ill. Dec. 9, 1863. No later record.

Harris, Tillman W.—Private May 13, 1862. Captured at Chickamauga, Ga. Nov. 24 or 26, 1863. Exchanged May 23, 1865.

Heard, C. J. A.—Private May 13, 1862. Died at home in 1862.

Heard, James—Private May 13, 1862. Captured at Vicksburg, Miss. July 4, 1863, and paroled there July 8, 1863. No later record.

Hill, J. M.—Private May 13, 1862. No later record.

(Born in Butts County, Ga. Feb. 10, 1837.)

Mathews, W. J.—Private May 13, 1862. No later record.

May, Benjamin—Private May 13, 1862. Wounded in 1864. Died of wounds in Fair Grounds Hospital #2 at Macon, Ga. June 12, 1864. Buried in Oakland Cemetery at Atlanta, Ga.

May, Joseph—Private May 13, 1862. Died in Atlanta, Ga. hospital July 10, 1862.

McDonald, John A.—Private May 13, 1862. Union records

show he was captured at Nashville, Tenn. Dec. 16, 1864. Released at Camp Chase, O. May 2, 1865. (Born in Ga. in 1847.)

McWhorter, D. Franklin—Private May 13, 1862. Captured and died at Crab Orchard, Ky. Oct. 15, 1862.

McWhorter, Newton A.—Private May 13, 1862. Captured at Vicksburg, Miss. July 4, 1863, and paroled there July 8, 1863. Received at Louisville, Ky., a Confederate deserter, Sept. 1, 1864. Took oath of allegiance to U. S. Govt. and was released north of Ohio River during war Sept. 26, 1864.

Moore, William H.—Private May 13, 1862. Captured at Vicksburg, Miss. July 4, 1863, and paroled there July 8, 1863. Died at Edward's Station, Miss. May 16, 1863.

Morgan, J. W.—Private May 13, 1862. Died in hospital in 1864.

Mosely, J. C.—Private May 13, 1862. Wounded at Peachtree Creek, Ga. July 22, 1864.

Nesbit, John A.—Private May 13, 1862. Wounded at New Hope Church, Ga. May 25, 1864. Died of wounds in R. & D. Hospital at Marietta, Ga. June 26, 1864.

Noles, Dennis M.—Private May 13, 1862. Wounded at Orange Court House, Va. July or Aug. 1862. Captured at Vicksburg, Miss. July 4, 1863, and paroled there July 8, 1863. Died at home in 1865.

Noles, W. P.—Private May 13, 1862. Surrendered at Greensboro, N. C. Apr. 26, 1865.

Oglesby, William—Private May 13, 1862. Died in Newton County, Ga. Sept. 20, 1862.

Wounded at New Hope Church, Ga. May 25, 1864. Pension records show he was surrendered at Greensboro, N. C. Apr. 26, 1865 (Born in Coweta County, Ga. Mch. 28, 1845.)

Smith, George M.—Private May 13, 1862. Wounded and captured at Vicksburg, Miss. July 4, 1863, and paroled there July 8, 1863. No later record.

Smith, T. H.—Private May 13, 1862.

Smith, William M.—Private May 13, 1862. No later record.

Stevens, W. B.—Private May 13, 1862. Detailed for light duty at Columbus, Ga. on account of disability Jan. 30, 1865.

Wyatt, John Henry—Private May 13, 1862. Wounded at Salt Lick, Ky. in 1862. Captured at Lexington, Ky. Oct. 24, 1862. Shipped from Louisville, Ky. to Cairo, Ill. Nov. 18, 1862. Received near Vicksburg, Miss. for exchange Dec. 8, 1862. No later record.
