Witnessed by Nancy Bull. While Robert is not named, surely these Halifax Bulls are the same as those from Brunswick, VA at earlier date.

Indenture made the 1st day of December, 1757, between Robert TAYLOR of Meherin Parish and George SIMMS, for 80 pounds, conveying 250 acres on South side of Meherin River on Coald Water Run, formerly granted by Patent to John RANDALL and conveyed to Robert TAYLOR. Witnesses were M. CHAPMAN, Isaac Row WALTON, and Nathan HARRIS. Acknowledged in Court on December 27, 1757, at which time Rebecca TAYLOR, wife of the said Robert TAYLOR,

appeared and relinquished her right of dower. Deed Book 6, page 220.

Indenture made the 27th day of December, 1757, between Robert BULL and Ambross HARWELL, for 45 pounds, conveying 150 acres, land conveyed from Thos. BULL to his son, Robert BULL and being part of a tract of land taken up by the said Thos. BULL, the patent dated January 12, 1746. Signed by Robert BULL and Rachell BULL. Witnesses were Thos. JACKSON, John HICKS, and Samuel JACKSON. Indenture and Memorandum of Livery of Seizin were acknowledged in Court on December 27, 1757, by Robert BULL and Rachel, his wife. Deed Book 6, page 222.

Indenture made the 27th day of December, 1757, between Thomas BULL and Lemuel HARWELL, for 30 pounds, conveying 99 acres, being part of a tract of land taken up by the said Thos. BULL by patent bearing date of January 12, 1746. Beginning at the mouth of a Great Branch thence up the said branch as it meanders to a white oak on the same and from thence to a white oak from thence to the dividing branch and thence down the said branch to Ralph JACKSONs line and up the said line and up the said line (sic) to the Beginning. Signed by Thos. BULL and Susanna BULL. Witnesses were Thos. JACKSON, John HICKS, and Samuel JACKSON. Indenture and Memorandum of Livery of Seizin were acknowledged by Thomas BULL and Susanna, his wife. Deed Book 6, page 223.

I recently got this letter on another list, and thought someone on Q-R might find it interesting, so I'm sending it on to you (with the author's permission). It doesn't appear to apply to my family, but nonetheless, it shows how fragile our name searching can be, when we don't know these things ... Barbara Weaver

According to the "GUILFORD CO, NC, a map supplement" by Fred Hughes, pgs. 56 & 57, a stream by the name of Bull Run was named 1752/53, apparently for a Richard BULL. Ca: 1772/3 this family had some "catastrophic event" happen (cause unknown), splitting this (by then) large family into 3 groups. Some changed their names to TALBOT, others to RANDAL and some stayed BULLS.

This little book goes on ... In 1767, John Bull was using the name of TALBOT (on Regulator petitions) and had a mill on upper Deep River (deed said John Talbot, formerly Bull.) In Dec., 1803 a John Bull with wife Hannah and children: Oney, Jackson, Elisabeth, John Leonard (Lenny) was granted legal right to change their name to Randal (maiden name of John's mother?) and in 1804 migrated to GA. (According to this book, John TALBOT was a member of Deep River Quaker Meeting and was the grantor of the land on which the Meeting was held.)

Does anyone have any further information on the family of John (BULL) TALBOT who had the mill on upper Deep River? Was he the one who changed his name in 1804 and moved to GA? (I do not believe so, because in 1805 the NC Legislation granted 14 Bulls the right to change their names to TALBERT and I believe John Talbot/Talbert was still in Guilford Co. at that time.)

John TALBOTS' land is now under water (City Lake at Jamestown) along with the original MENDENHALL Plantation.

RANDAL, JOHN LEONARD (1800-1874). John Leonard Randal, Republic of Texas senator and physician, was born on February 11, 1800, in Stokes County, North Carolina, the son of John and Hannah (Harvey) Bull, who petitioned the state of North Carolina to change their name and that of their four children to Randal. The General Assembly at Raleigh ratified the name change on December 22, 1803. Randal received his medical training at Cincinnati Medical College. He and his family were living in McNairy County, Tennessee, when, in the late fall of 1838, they moved to Texas and settled about a mile and a half south of San Augustine. Randal received his conditional certificate for land on June 7, 1839, and his unconditional

certificate on May 6, 1844. He constructed a large two-story house that functioned as his residence and as a hospital for his patients. He succeeded James Gaines in the called session of the Sixth Congress in 1842, as a representative of the Shelby, Sabine, and Harrison districts in the Senate. He was reelected to the same office in the Seventh Congress, 1842-43. He joined the United States Army during the Mexican War and was appointed assistant surgeon on March 3, 1847. He was assigned to the Twelfth Infantry on April 9 and resigned on August 3, 1847. In 1858 he sold his property in San Augustine County and moved to Smith County, where, on September 27, 1859, he purchased 640 acres a few miles northeast of Tyler. On May 10, 1862, Randal enlisted in the Army of the Confederate States of America, Twenty-eighth Texas Cavalry, as regimental surgeon; he was recruited by his son, regimental commander Col. Horace Randal. He was later appointed surgeon of the Second Brigade of Gen. John G. Walker's division. His service, primarily in Arkansas, was cut short by his failing health. On March 22, 1863, he submitted his resignation, which was accepted on June 9, 1863. He sold his farm in Smith County on August 22, 1863. In 1867 he was paying taxes on a section of land in Grimes County. In 1868 he disposed of that property and purchased a 130-acre farm in Brazos County a few miles from Bryan. Randal, an Englishman by descent, reputedly inherited a considerable estate in England but preferred to remain a citizen of Texas and refused to claim his inheritance. He was married to Sarah McNeil Kyle, a descendant of Lord Stanhope, and they were the parents of eight children. Randal died on his Brazos County farm in April 1874 and is said to be buried in the old Boonville Cemetery, although his grave is unmarked.

A Bull Story -- related by Tom Bull, via email, 07/05/2002

When I was about six (6) years of age, my father, T. C. Bull, showed me a picture of my great grandfather, Jeremiah (Jerry) Bull. He then told me a story that if true would explain why Jeremiah and members of his family had left Tennessee and moved to Arkansas. The story had been told to T. C. by his father, Thomas Cheatham Bull, which in turn had heard it from his father, Jerry Bull. My father said that Jerry Bull had run into some trouble after the Civil War, some carpetbaggers had stole his cattle and burned his barn in an attempt to make him sell his farm near Moscow, Tennessee.

Burial: 1881, Reneau Cemetery in Woodruff Co, Tennessee in an unmarked grave next to his daughter Martha Caroline Butterworth. There are 3 unmarked graves next to his: possibly Edna, Samuel, Stephen.

Probate: March 01, 1881, Probate papers contained physician's bill indicating that Edna and Samuel were treated in February 1880. Since there is no mention of Edna, Samuel nor Stephen in 1880 census, it is believe that they died prior to Jeremiah.

Property: 1871, Jeremiah sold his property in Fayette County to his brother Stephen C. and moved to Arkansas.

Residence: 1871, Jeremiah bought property in DeVew, Arkansas that became known as the Bulltown community. D. R., Matilda and Dempsey Jr. moved there with him.
